
Connecting a Chromebook to C2k Wireless

Overview

This information sheet explains the steps required to connect a Chromebook to C2k Wireless. This is a first-time only activity and would only need to be carried out again when the user account password has changed.

Prerequisites for connecting to C2k Wireless:

C2k User account must be a member of **Meru C2k Wireless** security group

Alternatively, for shared devices you can use the **shared accounts** located at C2k Exchange | My School | School Documents | Guest Wireless Folder.

Connecting the Chromebook

1. Power on Chromebook and in the Chrome signin/network window, log in as normal using your Google credentials or log in as Guest.
2. Click the WiFi icon in the bottom right of the screen and connect to the C2kwireless network. A settings dialogue will be displayed – please ensure the following is entered:

EAP Method – PEAP
Phase 2 Authentication – MSCHAPv2
Server CA Certificate – Do not check
Identity – c2ken\Password – C2k password
Click Connect button

11. The Chromebook will now connect to C2k Wireless
12. Once signed in you will be able to browse internet, download apps etc...
